Stylistics is a branch of linguistics which studies style, especially in works of literature. It has long fascinated academics working at the interface between language and literature.

It became established in the United Kingdom and the United States in the 1960s and has always been influenced by developments in linguistics, such as structuralism, generative grammar, functional linguistics, pragmatics, feminism, discourse analysis, corpus linguistics, pedagogy, literary theory and cognitive linguistics. Moreover, different schools have different assumptions and backgrounds such as the Russian Jakobsonian school, French structuralism, American Chomskian linguistics, and British tradition of J. R. Firth. Drawing on these disciplines, it has developed methods of analyzing texts and characterizing their stylistic features.

This six-volume collection is organized around research questions that can be investigated from various perspectives and shows major developments and current achievements. It brings together seminal articles from varied sources, making an important guideline for researchers seeking to develop the knowledge of Stylistics, and its continued evolution. Edited by a leading figure in the field, this work covers the multifaceted roots, the most important accesses and approaches of Stylistics, as well as function in other disciplines in an extensive way.
