

The owner of the anonymous 'Naej Collection' announces the publication of a trilingual catalogue featuring three hundred and twenty-three masterpieces of Japanese bamboo art. Although the entire history of the genre is covered, the Naej Collection is especially strong in works by leading artists from the formative period 1850–1950, when Japanese basketry was established as an independent medium, the great craft dynasties were founded, and first Osaka and then Tokyo emerged as major centres of creativity. More than 90 per cent of the baskets are signed and the catalogue breaks new ground by providing full details and photographs both of the signatures and of the storage-box inscriptions, which include much precious documentary information. The catalogue is thus not merely the visual record of a great collection but the essential reference work for a developing field of study and connoisseurship.

Following an essay outlining the evolution of bamboo art in Japan and a small section introducing earlier Chinese baskets and Japanese baskets in Chinese style, the bulk of the catalogue is organized by artistic lineages, starting with the founding father Hayakawa Shokosai I (1815–1897) and his successors and moving on to the other great craft dynasties based in Osaka, including large sections devoted to the Yamamoto Chikuryosai, Tanabe Chikuunsai, and Maeda Chikubosai lines. From catalogue number 192 the focus moves to the lizuka line in Tochigi Prefecture and Tokyo, with numerous works by Hosai II, Rokansai, and Shokansai. The story is then continued into the post-war period when artistic basketry came to be practised in many other parts of Japan and a new generation of masters emerged, supported by patrons in both Japan and the United States. Each of the 14 sections of dramatic colour plates (in most cases with both general and detail images) is followed by a section printed on matt paper with photographs of all the signatures and box inscriptions and biographies of each artist. The catalogue concludes with a bibliography, glossary, and artist index. All the information is provided in three languages: English, Japanese, and mainland Chinese using simplified characters.

Japanese Art: Critical and Primary Sources is a four-volume reference work offering a critical overview of the history and culture of Japanese art. Drawing upon a wide range of English-language texts, the volumes explore the diverse and changing material and visual cultures of Japan from the pre-modern period to the present day. Over 75 essays from Asia, North America and Europe are assembled in this set and they address four major themes—material cultures (Buddhist objects, ceramics, textiles, interiors), visual cultures (painting, calligraphy, photography), printed matter (wood-block prints, books) and the context for Japan's art history (networks of patronage, sites of artistic production and consumption). Each volume is separately introduced and the selected materials are presented thematically, and chronologically within categories. Together the four volumes of Japanese Art present a major scholarly resource for the field.



New Perspectives on Language and Education



The Japanese concept of *akogare* has become well known in TESOL-related literature in recent years, usually in the context of interracial sexual desire. In this far-reaching new study of the internationalization of Japanese Higher Education, Chisato Nonaka uses *akogare* as both an analytical lens and the object of enquiry, and ultimately reconceptualises it as the creation of a space where individuals negotiate and transcend their ethnic, national, racial, gender or linguistic identities. The book innovatively engages with the often controversial binary of Japanese/non-Japanese, and demonstrates how Japan (often thought of as a homogenous nation) may be at a critical crossroads where long-held assumptions about a singular 'Japanese identity' no longer hold true. The book has profound implications for how 'internationalization' can mean more than just the use of English.



Hayao Miyazaki's career in animation has made him famous as not only the greatest director of animated features in Japan, the man behind classics as *My Neighbour Totoro* (1988) and *Spirited Away* (2001), but also as one of the most influential animators in the world. Even today, examples of his cartoons appear in Japanese school textbooks.



This two–volume collection, supported by an in-depth introduction that addresses origins, actuality, endgame and afterlife, brings together for the first time contemporary documentation and more recent scholarship to give a broad picture of Japan's Treaty Ports and their inhabitants at work and play in the second half of the nineteenth century. Compared with their counterparts in China, the Japanese treaty ports cast a small shadow. They were far fewer—only four really mattered—and lasted for just under 50 years, while the Chinese ports made their centenary. Yet the Japanese ports were important. The thriving modern cities of Yokohama and Kobe had their origins as treaty ports. Nagasaki, a major centre of foreign trade since at least the sixteenth century, may not have owed so much to its treaty-port status, but it was a factor in its modern development.






